## **HELPING HANDS INC. ORGANIZATION**

### **OUR OBJECTIVES**

The mission of Helping Hands Inc. is to champion the causes of innocent children across the globe and empower them to live lives filled with courage, happiness and knowledge.

Many of the world's children are living in incredibly deplorable conditions, lacking food, clothing, health care and education. Some children are homeless with bleak prospects and little hope for the future. Helping Hands Inc. was formed to address and fulfill the needs of these children. Founded by Kaushalya Siriwardana, the organization works tirelessly to instill a renewed sense of self-worth through compassion, support and education as we seek to break the cycle of generational poverty.

**As we move deeper into our mission, the organization has begun planning the construction of chapters throughout the world to assist the needs of these children, addressing their most basic needs in a nurturing environment.**

### **HHI GLOBAL CHAPTERS**

While there are children throughout the globe in need of assistance, there are regions of the world that have significantly higher numbers of children who are homeless, orphaned or neglected. Outreaches sponsored by Helping Hands Inc. have already begun their mission through our chapters in India, El Salvador, Ghana, Nigeria, India, México and Garland, Texas, USA. Each of these chapters is dedicated to providing a stable, supportive and wholesome environment where children of all ages can receive the attention needed in order for them to develop into empowered individuals. Additional chapters are planned in Chicago, New York and California, USA.

## HHI GLOBAL CENTER

Located in Hunt County, Texas, USA, the Global Center will be constructed on 1200 acres approximately 45 minutes from the Dallas Metroplex. The Center will provide free access to world renowned alternative health professionals, supportive, fun, interactive education and recreation in a peaceful, natural environment. It will encompass every nation's cultures, history and traditions. The Global Center's hotel and guest quarters shall be surrounded by the International Educational Cultural Center (representing over 200 countries), a 2,000 seat outdoor theater, The World Organic Garden, The Center for Natural Health, a 150 acre lake, a state-of-the-art film studio, and a Nature Pavilion all surrounded by an approximately 4 ft. "Wall of Confidence" with each brick engraved with a name chosen by their supportive donors.

This peaceful setting will promote peer teaching and natural life enrichment. The education and learning practices from each culture will be combined to help needy children in all nations via the corresponding satellite HHI global chapters each with a representative at the HHI Global Center as a liaison to them, their local community and to their countries' Ambassador to the United Nations.

## HHI GLOBAL CENTER PROJECTS AROUND THE WORLD

Each Global Chapter will be dedicated to providing a stable family environment to the homeless, orphaned and less fortunate children from the age infant to 18 years of age. Children will attend nearby schools with the center providing transportation to and from school.

## SRI LANKA

### *Shree Padma Shanti Nivasaya*

Location: Kurunegala, Sri Lanka - this chapter will initially house up to fifty children, providing shelter, food, clothing, education and medical care. Five acres of land have been donated and a commitment has been made for financial funding.

## INDIA

### *Bharatha Maithree Ashram*

Location: 58/1 Smdhi Mege, Wardha, Maharashtra, India. Five acres of land have been donated by Bodhi Satva Babasaheb Ambedkar Buddhist Academy and a commitment has been made for financial funding. Actions to formulate the chapter have begun.

### *R. M. N. Naidu Gurukula*

Location: Bangalore, India.

These two centers in India will initially house up to two hundred children, providing them with shelter, food, clothing, education and medical care. The first global chapter to offer in-house cricket training will be in Bangalore, India. The training program was designed by J. K. Mehendra (HHI board member) and will provide the homeless children an opportunity to be selected for the Indian national Cricket team.

Our programs for the children include further education through scholarships from universities around the world.

## EL SALVADOR

### **Current Operating Global Chapter**

**Edwin Perez**, *School Superintendent*

The first operating global chapter in Latin America is located in Tonacatepeque, El Salvador. The chapter "Centro Escolar Distrito Italia, Tonacatepeque School currently has 1552 students. We are in the early stages of planning to build nearby housing for the communities. In addition, UN Ambassador Carlos Garcia has implemented a project for peace named "swimming pool for peace" the pool will be utilized by the communities. The object is to bring all the communities together to enjoy the pool in a relaxing atmosphere, to socialize so they will co-create harmony and peace. We need your support so we can purchase school supplies, clothing, shoes, hygienic items, and medical equipment. Ambassador Carlos Enrique Garcia Gonzalez, an ardent supporter of HHI, has been working tirelessly on this project.
